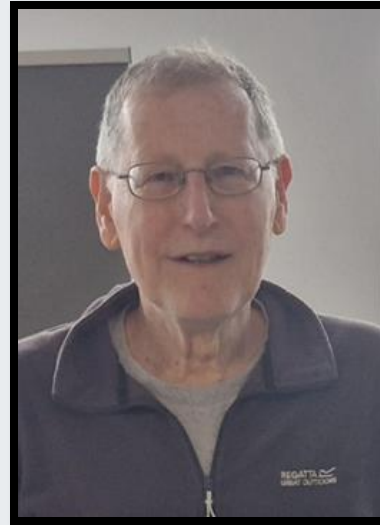

WHAT WE HAVE ACHIEVED IN UKRAINE



Worked with multiple partners. Established warehouse & distribution network. Delivered **16 hospital units** & **\$80 million plus of Medical Aid** donated by **Heart to Heart International**; ongoing.

Support for community-based services for children with special needs/disabilities in Odesa (**Key to the Future Project**) & to UCD Ukraine Trauma Project; ongoing.

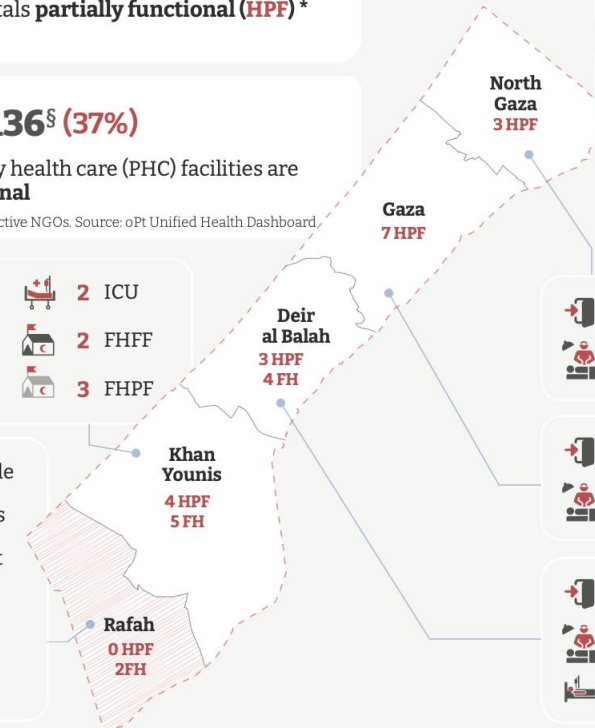

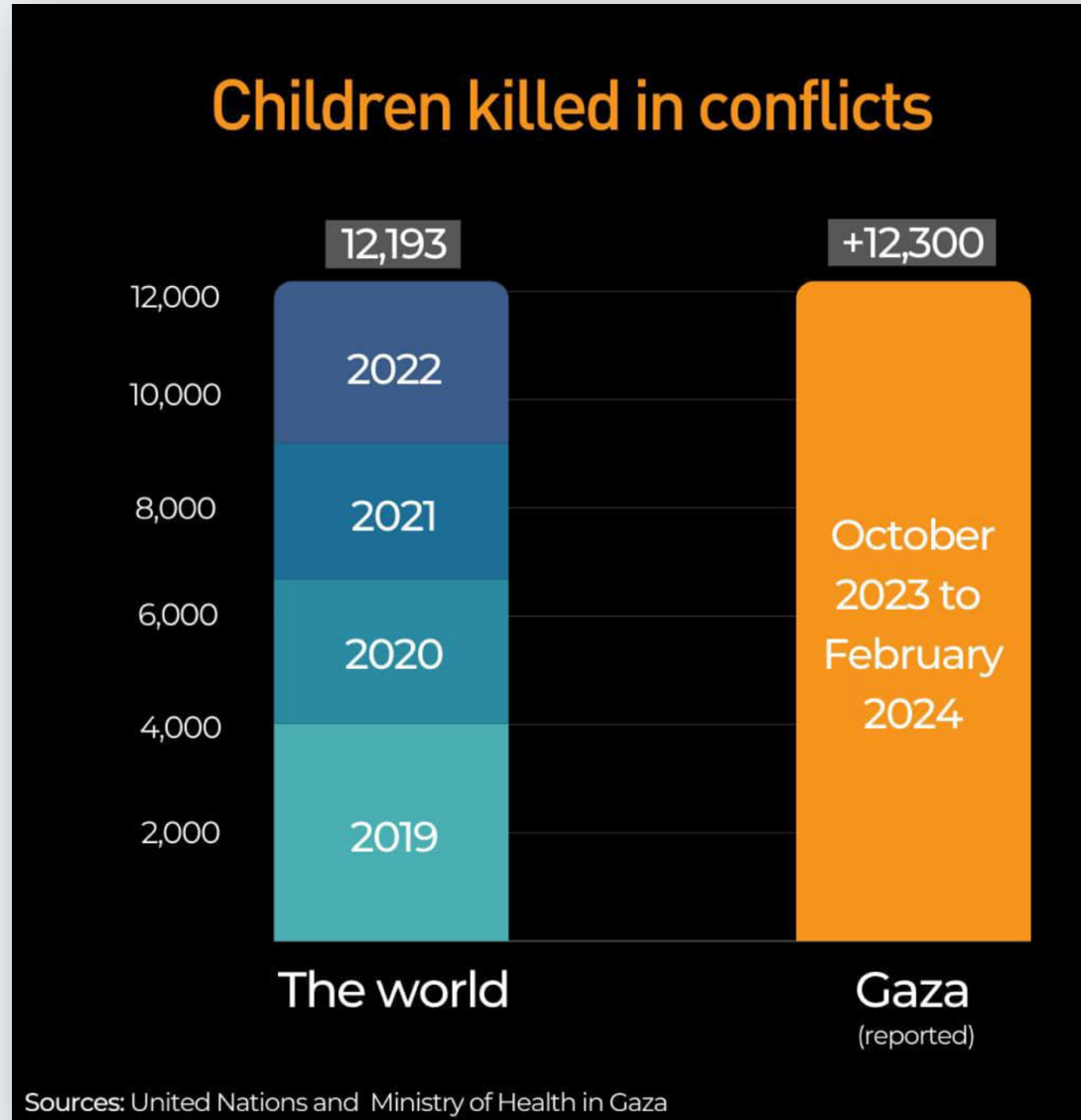

GAZA: DISPLACEMENT

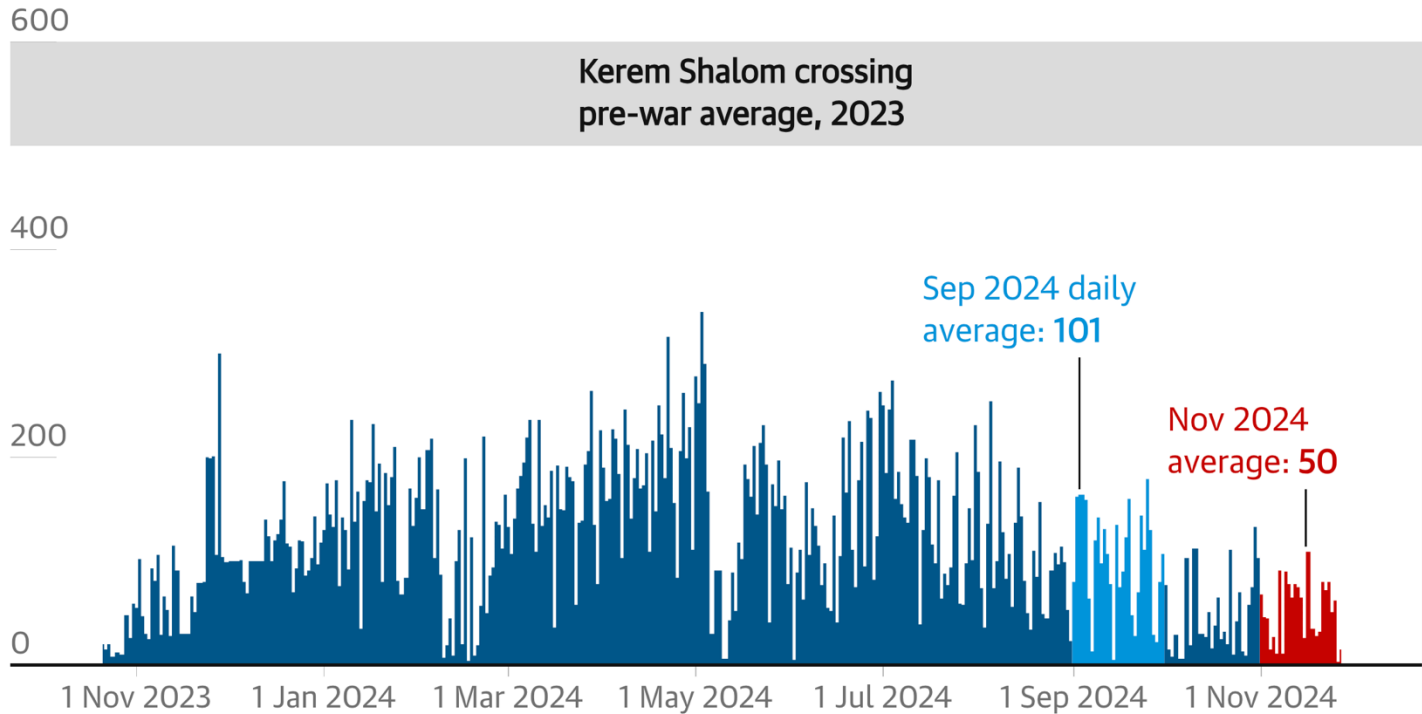

INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL CORPS FIELD HOSPITALS IN GAZA



- Funded by USAID
- Considerable logistical experience bringing medical aid into Gaza
- Fully compliant with all statutory regulations re importation
- Employ circa 1,000 Palestinian healthcare workers
- Act as main referral centres
- Work closely with WHO

Achievements since January 2024

PROVIDING
HUMANITARIAN AID IN



GAZA



- ✚ Provided 210,275 consultations
- ✚ Performed 7,052 surgeries, including major and moderate surgeries, and minor procedures
- ✚ Facilitated 2,591 births, including 588 caesarean sections
- ✚ Reached 13,233 people with MHPSS
- ✚ Screened 70,767 children under the age of 5—identifying and treating cases of moderate acute malnutrition (MAM) and severe acute malnutrition (SAM)
- ✚ Provided 40,618 people with gender-based violence prevention and response services
- ✚ Supported 21,969 children with psychological first aid (PFA), individual counseling and unstructured activities, including drawing, singing and dancing, and games—enabling children to explore their emotions in a child-friendly space
- ✚ Provided access to safe drinking water to 199,670 people and is producing more than 37,500 liters of clean water per day
- ✚ Procured 184 tons of medicines, medical equipment and supplies

O4H'S GAZA RESPONSE TO DATE

- ❑ **November 23 - June 24:** Due diligence re logistics & potential partners
- ❑ **July 24:** International Medical Corps (IMC) identified as ideal partner for aid delivery
- ❑ **August 24:** Fundraising commenced for first surgical unit. Target of €235k met within weeks – funded by Irish business community
- ❑ **September 24:** First surgical unit shipped to Gaza

O4H'S GAZA RESPONSE TO DATE

- ❑ **October 24:** Funds for second surgical (€300,00) donated by Irish medical institution; other Irish medical institutions agree to donations.
- ❑ **November 24:** First surgical unit arrives in Deir al Balah IMC Field Hospital, Gaza
- ❑ **December 24:** Orders placed for first consignment of essential medicines for IMC Field Hospitals
- ❑ **December 24:** One4Humanity & International Medical Corps agree partnership plan for 2025

O4H'S PLAN FOR 2025 WITH



- ❑ **Expand capacity of IMC's existing field hospitals**
- ❑ **Deliver essential medicines, equipment, and supplies**
- ❑ **Support additional services**
 - ❖ initially 3 additional hospital units (surgical, maternity, laboratory) to support partly destroyed hospitals (starting with the European Hospital, Khan Younis)
 - ❖ more hospital units may be required
 - ❖ mobility/flexibility of units facilitates redeployment/redesignation
 - ❖ infrastructural & medicines/kit funding may be need to be interchangeable
- ❑ **Support medical training & research in association with academic partners**
